**Administrative/Biographical History:** Leech was born into a secular working-class family in Ashton-under-Lyne in greater Manchester. As a teenager he became a Christian and a socialist after seeing Trevor Huddleston, a priest of the Community of the Resurrection, speak against apartheid at the Manchester Free Trade Hall in 1956.

Leech moved to the East End of London in 1958 when he began his studies for a degree in history at King's College London. He graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1961 and then went to Trinity College, Oxford. After theological studies at St Stephen's House, Oxford, he was ordained to the priesthood in 1965. He served in urban London parishes afflicted by poverty and confronted issues of racism and drug abuse. After ordination, he served for two years as a curate at Holy Trinity Hoxton in the East End of London and then from 1967 to 1971 at St Anne's Soho.

While in Soho, Leech set up the Soho Drug Group (1967) which ministered to young addicts, many of whom had been drawn into prostitution. In 1969, at the instigation of and in conjunction with Anton-Wallich-Clifford and the Simon Community, he established the charity Centrepoin which became the United Kingdom's leading national charity tackling youth homelessness. From 1971 to 1974 he was chaplain and tutor in pastoral studies at St Augustine's College, Canterbury. In 1974 he became rector of St Matthew's Bethnal Green where he served until 1979. While at St Matthew's he became deeply involved in the struggle against the National Front and other racist and fascist groups. In 1974, with Rowan Williams (who became the Archbishop of Canterbury) and others, he founded the Jubilee Group, a network of Christian socialists in Britain and across the Anglican Communion, most of whom were Anglo-Catholics. In 1980 he became Race Relations Field Officer for the British Council of Churches Community and Race Relations Unit. The following year he was named Race Relations Field Officer of the Church of England's Board for Social Responsibility. He was director of the Runnymede Trust, a think tank dedicated to promoting ethnic diversity in Britain, from 1987 to 1990. From 1991 until 2004, when he retired from full-time parish ministry, he was community theologian at St Botolph's Aldgate, a church located at the intersection of the City of London and the East End. As archbishop, Rowan Williams awarded him a Lambeth doctorate.

Leech was an advocate of contextual theology. As much as he admired the work of academic theologians, he insisted that authentic Christian theology could not be confined to the academy or to the pastor's study. He believed that it must be grounded in prayer and should be the work of the entire local Christian community across the boundaries of class, race and sex. At the heart of his faith was what he called "subversive orthodoxy"; the indissoluble union of contemplative spirituality, sacramental worship, orthodox doctrine

and social action. He argued that this conjunction of faith and the quest for justice, which points to the coming of the Kingdom of God on earth, is the essential mark of the Christian life and underlies Scripture, the teachings of the Church Fathers and the Christian mystical tradition. His work also drew on the radical and even revolutionary strands in Anglo-Catholicism represented by figures such as Stewart Headlam, Thomas Hancock, Charles Marson, Percy Widdrington, Conrad Noel and Stanley Evans. He respected the contributions of Frederick Denison Maurice, Brooke Westcott, Charles Gore, William Temple and other reform-minded Anglican Christian socialists, but thought them often to be too timid and middle class.

Although Leech was critical of theological liberalism, unlike some Anglo-Catholics he supported the ordination of women and the rights of gay and lesbian people. His publications include guides to prayer and spiritual direction, autobiographical reflections on urban ministry and theological critiques of capitalism and social injustice. Of his weightiest theological work, *True God* (published in the United States as *Experiencing God*), the philosopher Alasdair MacIntyre wrote that "there are few other books that state in so comprehensive a fashion what is at stake in believing or not believing in the God of Catholic Christianity".

Leech died in Manchester on 12 September 2015.

**Custodial History:** The Kenneth Leech Archive was deposited at the Royal Foundation of St Katherine in Limehouse when Leech retired from full-time ministry in 2004. It was catalogued partially whilst there in August 2007 and subsequent deposits were made up to 2014.

parish management, including: the work of Reverend Kenneth Leech at St Botolph's, Aldgate, social welfare issues, world religions, antisemitism, North American diocese, theological events, clergy administration, finances, theological research, Christian worship and faith practices, funerals and obituaries, the Jubilee Group, church services, and the Christendom Trust (1962-2012); papers, press cuttings, articles, journal extracts, reports, ephemera, and correspondence regarding social welfare issues and prejudice, including: drug addiction, drug policy, homelessness, racism, anti-racism campaigns, Black liberation activism, homophobia, xenophobia, fascism and fascist ideologies, healthcare for addicts, migrant communities in London, domestic violence and abuse, drug subculture in London, clergy attitudes to social welfare issues in Britain, refugees and asylum seekers, and urban living conditions (1962-2009); correspondence between Reverend Kenneth Leech, friends, clergy members, and customer services, regarding: clergy administration, personal celebrations and affairs, travel, TV licensing, theology, parish management, social welfare issues, and a missing persons case (1954-2014); press cuttings and journal extracts from various publications, regarding: social welfare issues, Christianity and Catholicism, theology, elections, peace movements, sports, health, international conflict and politics, addiction, world religions, fascism and antifascism, communism, socialism, trade unions, philosophy, sexuality, spirituality, book reviews, and political dissent (1962-2013); audio cassette tapes, CDs, DVDs, and VHS tapes featuring audio and video material, regarding: Christianity and Catholicism, theology, spirituality, racism, the East End of London, current affairs, and the life and beliefs of Reverend Kenneth Leech (1978-2009); publications, including books, journals, pamphlets, theses, and research papers, written by Reverend Kenneth Leech, the Jubilee Group, and various other authors, regarding: Christianity and Catholicism, theology, spirituality, social welfare issues, politics, East London, addiction, racism and immigration, radical and political activism, sexuality, counterculture, and psychology (1953-2017); personal artefacts created and owned by Reverend Kenneth Leech, including private documents, photographs, publications, certificates, and one scrapbook, regarding: East End of London, clergy work by Reverend Kenneth Leech, travel, school, ordination, and personal affairs (1957-2010); and miscellaneous papers, articles, posters, ephemera, postcards, maps, publication extracts, poetry, handwritten notes, and correspondence, regarding: social welfare issues, religious practice and spirituality, publications, clergy members and administration, racism and immigration, political activism, Christian and theological groups and events, memorials, obituaries and deaths, theological research, health and health services, fascism and antifascism, national and international politics, church events and services, clergy administration, and personal affairs (1962-2013) (1954-2017)
